**Kingston & District Agricultural Society (KDAS) Horse Show**  
**Kingston Fall Fair**  
**SEPTEMBER 16 - 18, 2011**

1. All competitors/exhibitors **MUST** be fully paid up members of the KDAS for the current year. Adult - \$6.00. Youth- (under 18) - \$1.00. Membership to be paid with entries.
  2. Entries will be accepted **ONLY** by the following methods:

3. **CLOSING DATE:** Show Day – 7:30 a.m. Hunter show; 7:30 a.m. Western Show; 12 noon Western Games.
  4. Entries are not considered complete without a correctly signed liability waiver form, payment in full and proof of liability insurance on the horse. Proof must be in the form of a current OEF membership or insurance agreement.
  5. **REFUNDS:** KDAS membership fee is non-refundable. Entry fees will be returned if cancelled 24 hours prior to first class entered with appropriate medical documentation. Once a horse has entered the show grounds there will be no refund unless authorized by the Kingston Fall Fair Horse Show Committee.
  6. All **NO SHOW** entries will be charged full entry fees and other applicable fees.
  7. A \$50.00 charge will be added to all accounts paid with cheques that are returned from the bank for any reason.
  8. Ponies may expect to be measured at the discretion of the Kingston Fall Fair Horse Show Committee.
  9. Show management reserves the right to change or amend show scheduling up to one (1) hour prior to the designated class. All classes will be offered. Show management reserves the right to not award prize money for any class that has three (3) entries or less two hours before the show is scheduled to start.
  10. In the event of a fall, horse and rider must leave the ring.
  11. English: Proper hunter show attire is mandatory. Well heeled field boots or paddock boots with half chaps All competitors **MUST** wear a correctly fastened (ASTM/SEI) approved helmet.  
Western: Correct western attire, western boots, long sleeved shirt (short sleeved shirts allowed for western games), Western hat. Pony competitors and competitors under 16 years of age **MUST** wear a correctly fastened (ASTM/SEI) approved helmet.
  12. There will be a 10 minute warning call before the start of classes. Failure to come to the in gate will result in elimination, without refund of entry fee.

13. Warm up in the Memorial Centre is open to any competitor competing on that day, but is restricted to the official hours. Entry numbers must be worn at all times when mounted.

18. Two phases –over fences and flat. Results from the over fences phase will determine whether or not the horse/rider combination qualifies to compete in the flat phase.  
Over fences phase consists of an equitation course to include any or all of the following: bending line, roll-back, halt, trotting a fence. The top eight horses from the over fences phases will be invited back for an equitation flat phase to determine placing. The fence height will not exceed 2'6".
